Thar be Pirtes in Scotland

March finds us in a tropical land dodging an erupting volcano and battling pirates. And where was this tropical land? Pirate Island Adventure Golf in Scotland, that's where!

This 18 hole course was built by Castle Golf for John Codona's Pleasure Fairs in Aberdeen, Scotland. The course is the latest addition to the Codona's beach front entertainment complex which includes rides, bowling, arcades, restaurants, bars and now adventure golf. The course contains a fort, a pirate ship, a volcano and an ominous skull that awaits your final shot.

Our job was to bring the pirates and the volcano to life.

The pirate battle includes firing cannons, water explosions and battle smoke. We also recorded custom dialog for the project and combined that with a musical score to complete the show tracks. To see more of the pirate battle check out the media page on our website.

Tribal drums wake the spirits of the volcano as the ground rumbles and the mountain gives up its lava. The volcano eruption utilizes a custom designed LED lighting package and 120 nozzles of water fog from both the waterfalls and top of the mountain.

All of the visual effects utilize different combinations of air, water and light to produce an exciting experience for the guest and a cost effect system for Codona's to operate.
